

Colorado Child Care Assistance Program

Eligible Activity:

- · Parents who are working
- Post-secondary education will be provided to parents for up to 104 weeks. (Study time will not be allowed for the purpose of this activity.)
- Up to 52 weeks for GED, ESL, or Adult Basic Education
- Teen parents (under age 21) in a high school diploma program, GED program, certificate, or education program.
- Families receiving Colorado Works/TANF that are completing countable work activities on their Individual Responsibility Agreement.
- Applicants must be **Jefferson County** residents.

ALL FAMILIES MUST BE IN ONE OF THE ABOVE LISTED ACTIVITIES AND INCOME MUST NOT EXCEED THE FOLLOWING GROSS MONTHLY INCOME:

Program Requirements

- Parents must continuously be in an eligible activity at initial application,
- Parents must provide income verification before approval.
- Families that qualify must directly pay "a parental fee" to their child care provider for a portion of the total cost, and
- Eligibility for continued assistance is re-determined every 12-months.
- If applicable, parents must cooperate with Child Support Services.

These are the primary factors used to determine eligibility for this program. Eligibility will be determined by Child Care Assistance Program staff when the applicant is complete and requested verification provided.
